Comments:

A significant rain event restricted the total weekly throughput for the Burdekin mills to just over 10,000 tonnes of cane. All of this was crushed at Invicta Mill on Sunday.

Kalamia stopped crushing operations early on Saturday morning followed by Pioneer and Inkerman on Saturday evening, with Invicta managing to maintain supply until Sunday night.

Rainfall totals of between 80 and 100mm were received across the district from Monday through to Wednesday. This resulted in wet ground conditions, making it impossible to continue to harvest.

Logistics staff will begin an assessment this week to determine a restart date.

The average weekly CCS was 12.96, which is well below budget due to the wet conditions. The highest CCS sample was 14.90 from a rake of Q240 P in the Mulgrave productivity zone (Invicta).
