Comments:

The Burdekin mills crushed just under 260,000 tonnes this week after widespread showers and thunderstorms disrupted harvesting across the district late in the week.

Just over 72 per cent of the forecast 8.15M tonne Burdekin crop has been crushed to date.

The average weekly CCS was 14.92, which is down on the previous week and below budget.

The highest CCS sample of 17.8 was from a rake of Q208-3R in the Jardine productivity area.

It has been a quiet few days while mills have been shut down due to wet weather, however trains will start to run again from Monday (24 October) and resume 24/7 operations.

Factories are expected to resume crushing operations from Tuesday (25 October).

Please remember to approach all cane rail crossings with caution and always give way to cane trains.
