Comments:

Burdekin mills crushed just over 82,000 tonnes this week after harvesting was disrupted due to wet weather.

Showers and thunderstorms persisted across the district over last weekend and returned on Thursday.

Invicta restarted crushing on Tuesday, with Kalamia and Pioneer restarting on Thursday before shutting down on Friday morning after showers and thunderstorms returned. Inkerman did not process any cane for the week.

High mud loadings have been causing processing issues in the factories.

Just over 73 per cent of the forecast 8.15M tonne Burdekin crop has been crushed to date.

The average weekly CCS was 13.51 which is down on the previous week and below budget.

The highest CCS sample of 16.4 was from a rake of Q208-4R in the Jardine productivity district.
