Comments:

The Burdekin mills crushed just over 290,000 tonnes for the week.

Harvesting did not restart at Kalamia Mill and Inkerman Mill until Monday after the wet weather event.

Throughput was significantly impacted by high mud loadings and low purity material.

Just under 77 per cent of the forecast 8.15M tonne Burdekin crop has been crushed to date.

The average weekly CCS was 13.48. While this is a slight recovery from the previous week, it is still below budget.

The highest CCS sample of 16.9 was from a rake of Q240-2R in the Stockham Rd productivity district.

Please continue to use your train brain and remain alert around our cane rail network. Do not linger near any part of the rail network, and only cross the line using designated crossings.

Remember our locos are towing heavy loads and can take up to 1km to come to a complete stop.

Our cane trains are in operation around the clock, seven days a week during the crushing season.
