#### **Comments:**

The Burdekin mills crushed just over 380,000 tonnes this week.

No rainfall was recorded last week and harvesting conditions are improving every day.

Throughput has been consistent, however rate is down due to factories processing low-purity material following the rain event.

A total of 80 per cent of the forecast 8.15M tonne Burdekin crop has been crushed to date.

The average weekly CCS was 13.44. This is lower than the previous week and will struggle to get back to pre-wet weather levels due to the lateness in the year and increasing temperatures.

The highest CCS sample of 17.3 was from a rake of Q240-2R in the Stockham Rd productivity district.
