Comments:

The Burdekin Mills crushed just over 345,000 tonnes of cane for the week.

No rainfall was recorded during the week however throughput was down due to scheduled cleans, unplanned stops and reduced crushing rates due to high dirt levels and low-purity cane.

Just over 85 per cent of the forecast 8.15M tonne Burdekin crop has been crushed to date.

The average weekly CCS was 13.23, with the season-to-date CCS now sitting on 14.01 units.

The highest CCS sample of 17.3 was from a rake of Q240-4R in the Jardine productivity district.

With the crushing season extending into the school holidays, we ask parents and caregivers to talk to children about the dangers of playing on or around our cane rail network.

Do not linger near any part of the rail network, and only cross the line using designated crossings.

Our cane trains are in operation around the clock, seven days a week during the crushing season.
