Comments:

The Burdekin mills crushed just over 42,000 tonnes of cane for the week.

Thunderstorms across the region earlier in the week brought harvesting and crushing operations to a halt for the remainder of the week.

Just under 89 per cent of the forecast 8.20M tonne Burdekin crop has been crushed to date.

The average weekly CCS was 11.81, with the season-todate CCS now sitting on 13.94 units. CCS levels have dropped since the onset of the recent wet weather events.

The highest CCS sample of 14.5 was from a rake of Q183-3R in the Mulgrave productivity district.

With the crushing season extending into the school holiday period, we ask parents and caregivers to talk to children about the dangers of playing on or around our cane rail network.

Our cane trains are in operation around the clock, seven days a week during the crushing season, including over the holiday period.
