## Comments:

The Burdekin mills processed just under 179,000 tonnes of cane for the week.

All four mills restarted crushing operations on Wednesday as ground conditions improved following the previous week's rain event.

Just over 91 per cent of the forecast 8.20M tonne Burdekin crop has been crushed to date.

The average weekly CCS was 11.4, with the season-to-date CCS now sitting on 13.88 units.

The highest CCS sample of 15.1 was from a rake of Q133-2R in the Aerodrome productivity district.

Wilmar Sugar plans to continue crushing through Christmas this year, provided there is adequate cane supply. Logistics officers are contacting growers to gauge their interest in harvesting over this traditional holiday period.

With school holidays under way, we ask parents and carers to remind children that cane trains will continue to operate into January this season.

Please keep your train brain switched on. Be alert, stay off our rail network and always give way to cane trains.
