#### Comments:

Throughput this week was just under 338,000 tonnes which again exceeded budget as the dry weather continues and all four mills settle in to some consistent crushing.

This brings the total cane crushed to date to just over 500,000 tonnes.

The average weekly CCS increased to 12.89 which reflects the volume of standover cane being delivered.

The highest CCS sample of 17.20 was from a rake of Q183-P in the Clare Productivity district.

With school holidays commencing at the end of this week, parents and caregivers are reminded to reinforce with children the dangers of playing on or near the cane railway network.
