Comments:

Throughput for the week was just over 395,000 tonnes, which is the highest weekly total for the season, to date.

This brings the total crop processed to just over 1.27 million tonnes.

The average weekly CCS increased to 13.82. This was a significant increase on the previous week and reflective of the dry conditions and the reducing proportion of standover in the cane supply.

The highest CCS sample of 17.0 was from a rake of Q183-P in the Pioneer Productivity district.

A rain event forecast for the coming week is expected to impact processing operations.

With school holidays still under way, parents and guardians are urged to remind their children about the dangers of playing on or near our cane rail network
