#### Comments:

Widespread rainfall of between 40 and 100mm across the Burdekin district saw processing halted at all mills by Tuesday. As a result throughput was restricted to just under 70,000 tonnes for the week.

This brings the total crop processed to date to just over 1.34 Million tonnes.

The average weekly CCS was 13.75, which, while still ahead of budget, was down on the previous week's results due to the wet conditions.

The highest CCS sample of 17.0 was from a rake of Q183-P in the Pioneer Productivity district.

All mills are taking advantage of the rain stop to carry out cleaning and maintenance tasks.
