Comments:

Throughput was just over 380,000 tonnes this week.

Necessary cleans at Pioneer and Invicta mills kept the total down, but Kalamia Mill recorded its highest throughput for the season at more than 83,000 tonnes.

The season-to-date total for the Burdekin mills has now exceeded 2.5M tonnes.

CCS is slightly below budget for the week but is increasing as field conditions dry out.

The highest CCS sample of 17.7 was from a rake of Q240-P in the Invicta Productivity Area.
