#### Comments:

More than 390,000 tonnes was processed this week.

Throughput exceeded budget at all four Burdekin mills thanks to another week of dry weather.

The season to date total for the Burdekin mills is now just under 3.7M tonnes which represents 45 per cent of the total forecast crop.

CCS increased again this week with the dry conditions but is still slightly below budget.

The highest CCS sample of 18.1 was from a rake of Q183-3R in the Invicta Productivity Area.
