Comments:

Just over 373,000 tonnes of cane were processed for the week.

The season-to-date total for the Burdekin mills is now just under 4.5M tonnes, which represents about 54 per cent of the total forecast crop.

CCS increased again, due to the ongoing dry conditions, and is now slightly over budget.

The week's highest CCS sample, of 18.1, was from rakes of Q240-2R in the Invicta productivity area.
