Comments:

The Burdekin mills processed just under 380,000 tonnes of cane this week.

Pioneer, Kalamia and Inkerman mills all exceeded budget for the week. Invicta Mill came in under budget due to cleaning intermissions and unplanned stops.

The season-to-date total for the Burdekin mills is now just under 6.9M tonnes, which represents about 85% of the total forecast crop.

The average weekly CCS dropped slightly with the dry conditions but still remains well above budget.

The highest CCS sample of 18.3 was from a rake of Q183-2R harvested in the Shirbourne Productivity Area.

As we approach the end of the 2023 season, planning and preparation is well underway for maintenance season activities.
