Comments:

Throughput was down due to widespread rain bringing harvesting operations to a halt in the early part of the week.

Due to soft ground conditions, harvesting and processing was unable to resume before the end of the week.

Just over 167,000 tonnes of cane were processed for the week, bringing the season-to-date total for the Burdekin factories to just over 572,000 tonnes.

The average weekly CCS was 13.60, which was above budget, helped by the cool, dry conditions.

The highest CCS sample of 16.90 was from two rakes of Q240-P in the Stockham Rd and Jardine (Invicta) productivity district.

Despite the recent wet weather impact, harvesting and factory operations will resume this week. Please remember to use your train brain and take care around our cane rail network.
