Comments:

The Burdekin mills processed just over 230,000 tonnes of cane for the week. All mills restarted after last week's wet weather event only to be impacted again by rain at the end of the week.

The season-to-date total is now 7.65M tonnes, which represents 93 per cent of the Burdekin region's crop forecast of 8.20M tonnes.

The average weekly CCS was 11.69, which is well below budget due to the wet weather and cane quality.

The highest CCS of 16.05, was from a rake of Q240 3R in the Leichardt (INK) productivity district.

During these school holidays, parents and carers are asked to remind children of the dangers of playing on or near the rail network. Burdekin mills will be operating well into December.
