Comments:

The 2025 production season began at all four Burdekin mills on Tuesday 3 June, despite some scattered showers on Monday night.

The factories got off to a good start overall and are now settling in.

Throughput for the week was just over 213,000 tonnes, which was above budget.

CCS is well below budget and the high proportion of standover cane being delivered would be contributing to this.

The sugar production season is now in full swing and cane trains are operating 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Motorists are reminded to take care around our cane rail network and always give way to cane trains.
