#### Comments:

Rain impacted harvesting on Sunday in the Pioneer and Kalamia areas and, to a lesser extent, at Inkerman and Invicta. Pioneer and Kalamia mills both shut down on Sunday night and carried out cleaning and maintenance.

Throughput for the week was just over 366,000 tonnes, which was above budget.

CCS is increasing and ahead of budget. The highest CCS recorded for the week was 16.6 from two rakes of Q183 plant cane, in the Mulgrave and Jardine productivity districts.

As the school holidays continue, parents and carers should remind their children of the dangers of playing on or around our cane railway network.
