Comments:

The four Burdekin factories processed just over 372,000 tonnes for the week. Kalamia and Inkerman mills both recorded the highest weekly throughput for the season to date, even with Inkerman losing 11 hours to bagasse reclaimer issues.

Invicta Mill's totals were down with A side going through a planned 12-hour clean, followed by a number of unplanned stops. B side went into an unplanned clean to take advantage of a cane supply gap.

Pioneer carried out a major clean resulting in 14 hours of downtime.

CCS was slightly ahead of budget this week. The highest CCS recorded for the week was 17.5 from a rake of Q240 1R in the Leichardt productivity district.
