#### Comments:

Throughput for the week was just over 380,000 tonnes, bringing the season to date total to 3.18M tonnes. This is just behind the budgeted total of 3.20M tonnes for this stage of the season.

Inkerman had a late restart on Sunday, losing about eight hours and then stopped on Monday morning for about 16 hours to enable crews to repair leaks in #11 pan.

Lost time for wet weather in the Burdekin region so far this season is 202 hours against a budget of 153 hours.

CCS increased from last week but was still below budget by 0.1 units. The highest CCS recorded for the week was 17.3 from a rake of Q240 2R in the Jardine productivity district.
