Comments:

The Burdekin mills processed just over 380,000 tonnes of cane for the week, which is above budget. This brings the total for the season to date to 4.72M tonnes, which is ahead of the budgeted 4.65M tonnes for this stage of the season.

Major stops were at Pioneer for repairs to No.1 mill, Invicta B side for a planned cleaning intermission, Inkerman for ash mixer repairs and at Kalamia following an external power supply issue.

Average CCS increased again from last week and at 15.16 is tracking above budget.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 18.3 from a rake of Q240 plant supplied from the Selkirk productivity district.

Parents and carers are asked to remind children to stay away from the cane railway network. Members of the public are urged to report any suspicious activity around our cane rail line to the police.
