Comments:

Throughput for the week was just over 390,000 tonnes which was above budget and the second highest weekly throughput for the season to date.

Pioneer Mill recorded its highest throughput for the season to date.

The Burdekin mills have now processed a total of 5.11M tonnes, which is ahead of the budgeted 5.01M tonnes for this stage of the season.

Major stops this week were for cleaning intermissions at Invicta (A) and Inkerman mills.

CCS increased again from last week and, at 15.38, is well above the budget of 15.08 units.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 17.6 from a rake of Q240 2R supplied from the Upper Haughton productivity district.

With school holidays coming up, parents and carers are asked to remind children to stay away from the cane railway network.
