Comments:

Throughput for the week was just under 364,000 tonnes, which is above budget despite an extended stop at Inkerman to carry out boiler tube repairs and a caustic clean.

Pioneer recorded its second highest throughput for the year to date. This brings the Burdekin region's season to date total to 5.47M tonnes. This is ahead of the budgeted 5.37M tonnes for this stage of the season.

Other major stops this week were for a broken slew cable in the bagasse bin at Kalamia and a B side clean at Invicta.

CCS declined from last week but, at 15.19, is still above the budget of 15.12 units.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 18.2 from a rake of Q240 2R supplied from the Jardine productivity district.

With school holidays under way, parents and carers are asked to remind children to stay away from the cane railway network.
