Comments:

Throughput for the week was just under 370,000 tonnes.

This brings the total for the season to date to 5.85M tonnes which is ahead of the budgeted total of 5.73M tonnes for this stage of the season.

Pioneer, Invicta and Kalamia all had cleaning intermissions during the week. The Pioneer stop was extended to clean boiler 2 ID fans and the Kalamia stop was extended to carry out boiler tube repairs.

CCS increased again this week and is ahead of budget due to the very dry conditions.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 18.2 from a rake of Q240 2R supplied from the Jardine productivity district.
