Comments:

Throughput for the week was just over 360,000 tonnes. This brings the total for the season to date to 6.21M tonnes which is ahead of the budgeted total of 6.08M tonnes for this stage of stage of the season.

Major stops for the week were at Kalamia to repair a mill return bar, Inkerman A side to repair a broken cane carrier chain and Invicta A side for a scheduled clean.

CCS increased again this week to 15.51 which is ahead of budget due to the very dry conditions.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 18.4 from a rake of Q208 2R supplied from the Jardine productivity district.

Members of the public are urged to stay clear of the rail network, take care at road crossings and report any suspicious activity around our cane rail line to the police.
