Comments:

Throughput for the week was just over 320,000 tonnes. This brings the total for the season to date to 6.53M tonnes, which is ahead of the budgeted total of 6.43M tonnes for this stage of the season.

There was a significant unplanned stop at Pioneer Mill, which lost nearly three days when the Boiler 2 FD fan went out-of-balance and required lengthy repairs and re-balancing. Invicta B side lost about 32 hours due to a tube leak in Boiler 3.

CCS fell below budget this week due to the Pioneer stop and the impact on actual CCS. The other three mills were still over budget.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 18.5 from a rake of Q208 2R supplied from the Jardine productivity district.

Members of the public are urged to stay clear of the rail network, take care at road crossings and report any suspicious activity around our cane rail line to the police.
