Comments:

Throughput for the week was just under 360,000 tonnes. This brings the total for the season to date to 6.89M tonnes, which is ahead of the budgeted total of 6.78M tonnes for this stage of the season.

High fibres and declining cane quality are affecting rates at all the mills. The dry conditions are keeping CCS levels high.

Mill performance has been consistent, with the major stops this week being for planned cleaning intermissions at Invicta and Pioneer mills.

CCS is above budget for the region, however it is slightly below at Invicta.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 18.0 from a rake of Q240 3R supplied from the Stockham Road productivity district.

We're now in the final weeks of the 2025 season. Kalamia Mill is expected to crush out on Saturday 25 October. Invicta and Pioneer mills are expected to finish by the end of the following week. Inkerman is expected to finish in the first week of November.

Please continue to take care around our cane rail network.
