Comments:

Throughput for the week was just under 360,000 tonnes. This brings the total for the season to date to 7.25M tonnes, which is ahead of the budgeted total of 7.12M tonnes for this stage of the season.

Kalamia Mill finished crushing early on Saturday morning. The remaining mills have been crushing consistently, although rates are being impacted by cane quality.

CCS is still slightly above budget for the region.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 18.6 from a rake of Q183 4R supplied from the Jardine productivity district.

We're now in the final weeks of the 2025 season. Invicta and Pioneer mills are expected to finish in the coming week. Inkerman is expected to crush out in the first week of November.
