Comments:

Throughput for the week was just over 226,000 tonnes. Kalamia Mill has finished the season. Invicta, Pioneer and Inkerman mills had unplanned stops.

This brings the total for the season to date to 7.47M tonnes, which is still just ahead of the budgeted total of 7.46M tonnes.

CCS is well below budget for the week with declining cane quality.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 17.8 from a rake of Q240 3R supplied from the Jardine productivity district.

We're now on the final run for the 2025 season. Invicta and Pioneer mills are expected to finish in the first days of November. Inkerman is currently expected to finish by 10 November.
