Comments:

Throughput for the week was just over 117,000 tonnes with Invicta and Pioneer processing the last cane for the year.

This brings the total for the season to date to 7.59M tonnes, which is behind budget due to the reduced crop size.

Harvesting will be complete at Inkerman by Sunday (9 November). The mill is expected to crush out in the early hours of Monday morning (10 November), bringing the Burdekin season to a close.

CCS is well below budget for the week with deteriorating cane quality.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 17.4 from a rake of Q183 3R supplied from the Koolkuna productivity district.
