Comments:

Throughput for week two of the 2026 season was just over 370,000 tonnes, which was well above budget.

The Burdekin factories have now settled in and are performing well. Major stops reported for the week were at Invicta Mill for intercarrier repairs and Pioneer Mill for tippler motor repairs.

Average weekly CCS was 13.93 – more than a unit above the budgeted figure of 12.70.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 16.70 from a rake of Q183 first ratoon supplied from the Jardine productivity district.

We had a near miss reported last week at Giddy's junction. It was caused by the driver of a car attempting to race the lights. This is not only dangerous, but illegal.

A timely reminder for all motorists to obey all signs and signals and always give way to cane trains.

Cane trains can't swerve and they can't come to stop quickly. It can take a fully loaded cane train up to a kilometre to stop after its brakes are applied.
