Comments:

The 2026 production season began at three of the Burdekin mills on 2 June with Kalamia Mill commencing the following day. Conditions for the start of season were dry and cool.

Throughput for the week was just over 183,000 tonnes. Week one is all about commissioning plant and equipment and this process went well with factories now starting to settle.

Average weekly CCS was 13.59 units, which is well above budget due to the dry and cool conditions leading up to the start of season.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 16.4 from a rake of KQ228 Plant supplied from the Houghton productivity district.

The sugar production season is now in full swing and motorists are reminded that our cane trains are operating around the clock, seven days a week.

Please remember to use your train brain and always give way to cane trains.
