Comments:

Throughput for week four was just over 370,000 tonnes, which was above budget.

The Burdekin mills have now processed over 1.2M tonnes of cane for the season to date.

Inkerman Mill had a strong week with 88,000 tonnes processed – its highest weekly throughput for the season to date. Invicta Mill's total throughput was down due to a derailment on the Upper Houghton main line on Saturday.

Average weekly CCS was 14.23 – more than a unit above the budgeted figure of 13.26.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 16.90 from a rake of Q240 plant cane supplied from the Inkerman productivity district.

We had a concerning incident reported this week in which members of the public interfered with our cane railway infrastructure, creating the risk of a derailment. While most people take our cane safety messages seriously, it is disappointing that some are putting our cane trains and our people at risk.

If you notice any suspicious activities around our cane railway network, please make a police report.
