Comments:

Throughput for week five was just over 380,000 tonnes, which was above budget and the highest throughput for the season to date.

Kalamia Mill had a strong week with more than 83,000 tonnes of cane processed – its highest weekly throughput for the season to date.

Average weekly CCS was 14.40, close to a unit above budget.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 17.60 from a rake of Q183 plant cane supplied from the Jardine productivity district.

As we progress through the season, I'd like to remind harvesting groups of the importance of following siding procedures. These procedures are designed to safeguard the safety of all users, and maintain the efficient operation of our sidings. Please check that all of your operators have completed the mandatory siding induction.
