Comments:

The Burdekin mills have passed the two million tonnes crushed milestone.

Throughput for week six was just over 390,000 tonnes of cane, which was well above budget and the highest throughput for the season to date.

Invicta Mill had a strong week with more than 157,000 tonnes of cane processed – its highest weekly throughput for the season to date.

Average weekly CCS was 14.70, close to a unit above budget.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 17.30 from a rake of Q240 plant cane supplied from the Barratta productivity district.

Harvesting operators are again reminded to follow siding procedures when delivering or collecting bins. These procedures are designed to safeguard the safety of all users and maintain the efficient operation of our sidings. Please check that all your operators have completed the mandatory siding induction.

Members of the public are urged to stay clear of the rail network, take care at road crossings and report any suspicious activity around our cane rail line to the police.
