Comments:

Throughput for week seven was just over 356,000 tonnes of cane, which was down on the previous week but still above budget.

Inkerman Mill had a strong week with more than 90,000 tonnes of cane processed – its highest weekly throughput for the season to date.

Invicta and Pioneer mills both had cleaning intermissions last week. Invicta Mill had a bagasse conveyor choke resulting in 28 hours of downtime. Kalamia had an unplanned stop to enable repairs to No.1 mill.

Average weekly CCS was 14.95, close to a unit above budget.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 17.30 from a rake of Q240 plant cane supplied from the Barratta productivity district.

Members of the public are urged to stay clear of the rail network, take care at road crossings and report any suspicious activity around our cane rail line to the police.
