Comments:

Throughput for week eight was just over 340,000 tonnes of cane, bringing the season total to more than 2.7M tonnes.

Invicta, Kalamia and Inkerman mills all had cleaning intermissions last week. Invicta Mill had a fire in the compressor room, resulting in 30 hours of downtime on A side and 23 hours on B side.

Average weekly CCS was 15.11, close to a unit above budget.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 18.10 from a rake of Q240 first ratoon cane supplied from the Mulgrave productivity district.

We have reviewed concerning video footage from a locomotive showing a member of the public driving through a rail crossing and narrowly avoiding a collision with an approaching train.

This incident serves as a timely reminder of the importance of being vigilant around rail crossings and always giving way to cane trains.

Trains cannot swerve and they cannot stop quickly. It is up to drivers, cyclists and pedestrians to give way at rail crossings. Always obey crossing signals, warning lights and signage, and never attempt to cross if a train is approaching.

Please remember to use your train brain and take care around our cane rail network.
