Comments:

The Burdekin mills have now passed the 3M tonnes milestone.

Throughput for week nine was just under 390,000 tonnes of cane. This was the second highest throughput for the season, in a week that included a cleaning intermission at Invicta Mill.

Average weekly CCS was 15.09, which is more than 0.70 of a unit above budget.

The highest CCS recorded for the week was 17.30 from a rake of Q240 first ratoon cane supplied from the Barratta productivity district.

With the high winds we have had several reports of uncontrolled empty bins. Please ensure bins in sidings are secured at all times.

Harvesting operators are again reminded to follow siding procedures when delivering or collecting bins. These procedures are designed to safeguard all users and maintain the efficient operation of our sidings. Please check that all of your operators have completed the mandatory siding induction.

Please remember to use your train brain and take care around our cane rail network.
