#### Comments:

Crushing operations commenced at Inkerman Mill on Monday 15 June and at Pioneer Mill on Tuesday 16 June. All four Burdekin mills are now crushing.

Total throughput of just over 230,000 tonnes was achieved for the week.

All mills are crushing well however wet field conditions are still impacting throughput. A stop is planned for Inkerman on Thursday to carry out some necessary maintenance works

The highest CCS sample was 15.3 from a rake of KQ228 plant cane recorded in the Kalamia area.
