Comments:

There was a solid performance from all Burdekin mills this week. Some rain in the Clare and Shirbourne areas on Thursday interrupted supply to Invicta Mill for a short time on Friday and a broken pressure feed roller at Pioneer Mill stopped crushing for a period of time on Saturday night.

Total throughput of just over 400,000 tonnes was achieved, which is again above budget.

The highest CCS sample was 17.0 from a rake of Q240 plant cane in the Pioneer area.

A big thanks to the Burdekin community for making this school holiday period largely incident free.
