Burdekin

Crushing resumed at Inkerman Mill early on Monday morning, Kalamia Mill on Monday afternoon and Pioneer Mill on Tuesday afternoon following a wet weather interruption the previous week.

Crushing operations were going well until rain again disrupted harvesting in all mill areas except Invicta on Friday afternoon. Full crushing operations resumed on Sunday.

Total throughput of just over 270,000 tonnes was achieved for the week, and Invicta Mill has now crushed more than 1 million tonnes for the season to date.

Cane quality issues impacted crushing operations after the wet weather stop, but has improved.

The highest CCS sample was 17.4 from a rake of Q240 plant cane in the Invicta area.

Close to 30 per cent of the crop has now been processed.
