### Comments:

All four of Wilmar Sugar's Burdekin mills commenced crushing on Tuesday 8 June as planned.

After working through some early commissioning issues, the factories were crushing consistently by the end of the week.

Weekly throughput was just under 210,000 tonnes of cane.

Average weekly CCS was 12.83 which is above budget due to cool and fine weather conditions leading up to the start of crushing.

The highest CCS sample was 15.7 from a rake of KQ228 Plant cane in the Pioneer Mill productivity zone.

With crushing now in full swing, Burdekin residents and visitors to the region are urged to take care around cane rail crossings and use their train brain.
