Comments:

Crushing resumed at Inkerman and Kalamia mills last week after rain brought harvesting to a standstill the previous week.

Inkerman restarted on Thursday and put through just over 35,000 tonnes of cane. Kalamia restarted on Friday and put through just over 22,000 tonnes.

Invicta and Pioneer mills are on track to restart on Monday, 13 September.

Ground conditions remain damp in some areas but are drying out well.

Average weekly CCS was 14.66, which is below budget due to the effects of the wet conditions.

The highest CCS sample was 16.9 from a rake of Q208 second ratoon in the Kalamia Mill area.

With school holidays starting on Friday 17 September, we ask parents, carers and teachers to remind children about the dangers of playing on or around our cane rail network.

The travelling public is also reminded to 'Use your train brain' and always give way to cane trains.
