## Comments:

Just under 25,000 tonnes crushed at Inkerman this week due to a combination of wet weather, a boiler superheater loop failure and challenges processing the stale cane in bins.

The average weekly CCS dropped to 13.66, which is below budget due to the rain.

The highest CCS sample was 16.6 from a rake of Q240 third ratoon in the Inkerman Mill area.

Inkerman Mill employees worked tirelessly to repair the failed superheater loop and associated damage over the weekend, to enable the mill to resume crushing operations.

We are working closely with growers and harvesting operators to process the remains of the 2021 crop.
