## At a glance

Wilmar Sugar Australia's Queensland operations span the sugarcane value chain, from cane growing to production of raw sugar, renewable electricity, bioethanol and sustainable agricultural products.

Our eight sugar mills are located in the Herbert, Burdekin, Proserpine and Sarina regions, and have been operating for more than a century.

Our Sarina Distillery manufactures bioethanol for the fuel and industrial markets, while our Oonooie facility makes liquid stockfeed and fertiliser for primary producers.

We're also a joint-venture partner in Sugar Australia, which operates Racecourse Refinery in Mackay and a sugar packing facility at the Mackay Port.
