At a glance

The Burdekin region is the sugarcane capital of Australia.

Wilmar Sugar Australia has four sugar mills in the Burdekin: Invicta, Pioneer, Kalamia and Inkerman. Together, they contribute more than half of our total annual raw sugar production.

Invicta Mill, at Giru, vies with our Victoria Mill, at Ingham, for the title of Australia's largest sugar mill.

Raw sugar manufactured in the Burdekin is transported by rail to the Port of Townsville, where it is stored in a bulk terminal before being exported to international markets.
