



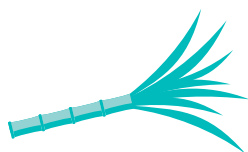
HERBERT REGION

At a glance

Wilmar Sugar and Renewables owns two sugar factories in the Herbert region.

Macknade Mill was established in 1873, making it the oldest operating sugar mill in Queensland. Victoria Mill was established in 1883 and is one of the largest sugar mills in Australia, processing about three million tonnes of sugarcane each year.

The raw sugar manufactured at our Herbert factories is transported by rail to the Port of Lucinda, where it's stored in a bulk terminal before being shipped to customers around the world.

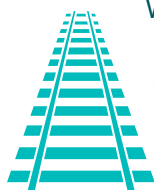
