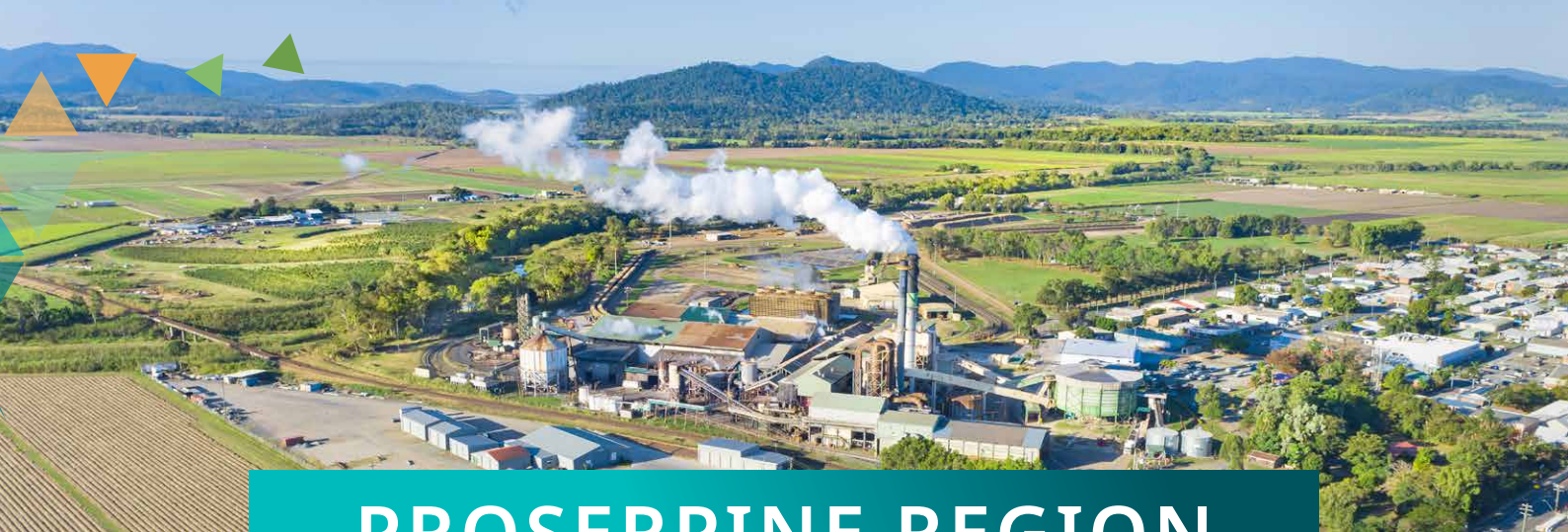




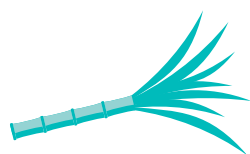
PROSERPINE REGION

At a glance

Proserpine Mill was established in 1897 and led to the development of the town of Proserpine, located in the world-renowned Whitsunday region.

The mill was owned by a grower cooperative from 1931 until 2011, when it was purchased by Wilmar Sugar and Renewables.

Raw sugar manufactured at Proserpine Mill is transported by rail to the Port of Mackay, where it is stored in a bulk terminal before being shipped to domestic and international markets.
