At a glance

Wilmar Sugar and Renewables has three sites in the Sarina region: Plane Creek Mill, Sarina Distillery and the Oonooie fertiliser and stockfeed facility.

Plane Creek Mill was established in 1896 and produces raw sugar, molasses and renewable energy. It provides steam and power to the neighbouring bioethanol distillery, which began operations in 1927.

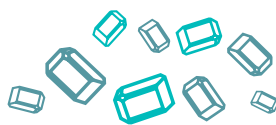
The Sarina Distillery is one of Australia's leading manufacturers of bioethanol, and the only large-scale producer of ethanol from molasses. Our bioethanol is used in fuel and a wide range of industrial applications.

The nutrient-rich co-product of ethanol production – dunder – is used in renewable liquid fertiliser and stockfeed products.
